TEAMhealth2 (Training, Employ, Advance, Mentor) is a Certified Nursing Assistant Training and Career Laddering Program with concurrent trainings in allied health professions. Career Laddering opportunities include CNA II, Certified Medication Technicians, Licensed Practical Nurses, and Registered Nurses. Trainings for allied professions include Home Makers, Medical Billing, and Medical Office Assistant. The program follows the model practices of the National Fund for Workforce Solutions by providing strong assessments, job readiness, case management, and employer development activities through collaborations with an array of training, and employer partners

Primary Partners -

Saint Antoine Residence, established in 1913, is a 260-bed skilled nursing facility located in North Smithfield, RI. It is the largest facility of its kind in the state. Saint Antoine provides long term care, short-term rehabilitation, Alzheimer's/dementia care, and a Hospice Suite for end-of-life care. The Residence employs close to 400 people and engages more than 150 volunteers. Its mission is to meet the physical, social, emotional and religious needs of older adults and their families by providing excellent care by compassionate professionals. **Family Resources Community Action**, established in 1892, is one of the oldest child serving and family support organizations in Rhode Island. It is dedicated to serving low-income families in Woonsocket and throughout Northern Rhode Island. More than 80% of the families and individuals served by FRCA live at or below the poverty level. Its services include employment and training, basic needs assistance, early childhood services, housing and shelter, child welfare, counseling and family support, and HIV/AIDS support.

Target population - TEAMhealth2's target population is incoming and/or incumbent entry level, low skilled/low income, and under-employed adults, who experience barriers to employment and therefore economic opportunity. The target geographic area is Northern Rhode Island.

Accomplishments - Over the past three years, in which the original teamHEALTH program operated, 166 under skilled and under employed people became Certified Nursing Assistants and were gainfully employed. An additional 45 people completed or were on a career path to become Certified Medical Technicians, Licensed Practical Nurses, and Registered Nurses.

Funding - Primary funding for TEAMhealth2 comes from the United Way of Rhode Island's Skill-Up Program. Matching funds have been supplied by the Rhode Island Foundation, Ocean State Charities Trust, Blanche Walsh Trust, Northern Rhode Island Area Health Education Center, and proceeds from Saint Antoine's Annual Golf Tournament. Additional funding comes from the Rhode Island Workforce Investment Act and private individuals.
