## ➔ Employment Transportation Information & Resources

### **Public Transit**

- ⇒ RIPTA Fixed Route and FLEX Bus

## ➔ Transportation Education & Planning

Consultation on transportation issues is available. Case Managers work with individuals enrolled in Family Resources Community Action's Employment & Training Programs to assess their employment transportation needs and develop a personal transportation plan.

### **Areas include:**

- ◆ Employment/job training location
- ◆ Child care location
- ◆ Transportation reliability & backup
- ◆ Transportation subsidies
- ◆ Driver's license concerns
- ◆ Car ownership

### **Educational workshops on topics such as:**

- ◆ Transportation Budgeting & Money Management
- ◆ Carpooling
- ◆ Travel Training
- ◆ Driver Safety



## ➔ New Transportation Service Development

The Center works to develop programs in northern RI to help people get to work, job training and college.

### **Focus areas include:**

- ⇒ Advocating to improve the public transit system.
- ⇒ Partnering with government, businesses and local organizations to help workers commute to 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> shift jobs.
- ⇒ Promoting and developing green transportation alternatives (biking, carpooling, car sharing, etc.)
